JURONG ISLAND RENEWABLE ENERGY REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

1. You are cordially invited to participate in the above Request for Proposal (RFP).

3. There will be a virtual briefing to interested applicants for the Jurong Island Renewable Energy RFP on 15 November 2021. Attendance for the briefing is **optional**. Interested applicants may register for the virtual briefing through this link (<https://form.gov.sg/61711e1b9e75310013b4f8d1>) by 12 November 2021, 2359 hrs. The link to the virtual meeting will be sent to the registered email.

APPLICATION DETAILS

4. The Applicant shall be led by a private sector company, preferably a **local¹ Small and Medium Enterprise² (SME)**, and can partner other private sector companies, Institute of Higher Learnings (IHLs), Research Institutes (RIs), public sector agencies and/or not-for-profit organisations. For non-local-SME-led Applicant, local SME(s) should be involved in a substantive and meaningful way (e.g. core technology must be from/or co-developed with local SME(s)).
5. The deadline for submission shall be on **24 January 2022, 1600hrs (Singapore time, GMT+8) ("Closing Time")**. Format of submission should **strictly adhere** to the submission guidelines provided in [Q3 Project Proposal Template](#).
6. Applicants are **strongly advised** to visit the IPI website: jirfp.innovation-challenge.sg regularly for any Corrigendum / Addendum to the Jurong Island Renewable Energy RFP which are issued prior to the Closing Date and Time. Acknowledgement of receipt by companies is not required as any published Corrigendum / Addendum is deemed to form part of the RFP.

¹ Local applicants should have $\geq 30\%$ of its ordinary shares held directly or indirectly by Singaporeans/Singapore Permanent Residents. This is determined by the ultimate individual ownership of the applicant.

² A SME is defined as having (i) Group Annual Sales Turnover of not more than S\$100 million; or (ii) Group Employment Size of not more than 200 workers.

- 7. For any clarification, please submit them through this link (<https://form.gov.sg/61711bd9a4b4e900123586ff>) at least ten (10) working days before the Closing Date, failing which EMA and JTC shall have the discretion to disregard all such queries.
- 8. Successful proposals which are accepted and approved by EMA and JTC can expect notification by Q3 2022. Awarded projects will commence thereafter.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES (SUBMIT VIA IPI WEBSITE ONLY)

9. Submission Procedures:

- a) Step1: Visit the IPI website: jirfp.innovation-challenge.sg to download the Jurong Island Renewable Energy RFP documents and understand the requirements of the Challenge Statements.

Step 2: Submit your proposal and all supporting documents in PDF (except proposal budget in Excel) on the IPI website: jirfp.innovation-challenge.sg, and in **strict accordance** to the following submission guidelines.

- Label the folder comprising the files as: **[Proposed Title] by [Company Name] (E.g. XYZ by ABC)**
- Label all files in the following manner: **Company Initials_Item Code** (e.g. ABC_01_Project Proposal), with the reference to the table below.
- You are required to submit **Item Code 01 to 06, and OD** if applicable.
- For submission of any other documents that do not fall under Item Code 01 to 06, place them under Item Code OD. For Item Code OD, please include a content page if information is substantial.
