1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>After deployment of solution at the end user's facility, data collection may be required to understand the challenges and to fulfil proposed milestones/KPI. As this process may take up to 1 year, should the data collection be incorporated as part of proposal? Or can we request for extension upon completion of deployment?</li> </ul>	<p>The stipulated project period is two years, with a maximum extension of not exceeding six (6) months. Applicant can propose suitable milestones within this two-year development period. You might wish to assess the scope of the data collection to be incorporated in your proposal based on this timeframe.</p>
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Are proposals covering more than 1 challenge statement (but costs more) favourably assessed over proposals covering only 1 challenge statement?</li> </ul>	<p>EMA and JTC will assess each proposal according to the evaluation criteria stipulated in Information Letter para 1.5. If you assessed that there might be synergy or cost savings in the solutions covering more than 1 challenge statement, we welcome you to do so. Alternatively, applicant may choose to submit separate proposals to address different problem statements.</p>
